QUARTERLY REPORTS FOR PASTORS

Healthy church planters need a family of supporters and advisers around them. They are stewards and leaders; they are both overseers and are overseen. They have friends who care for them and know them. The Apostle Paul told Titus in Titus 1:7 that "an overseer, as God's steward, must be above reproach." Furthermore, Paul said, in 1 Corinthians 4:2, that "it is required of stewards that they be found trustworthy." With that in mind, these reports are due to the Home Missions team four times during the year. 1) The Initial Report to be given within two weeks of receiving the first installment of the grant, 2) The 90-day Report, given on the fifteenth day of the month after the first 90 days of receiving the first payment, 3) The Mid-term Report, to be given after the six month mark, and 4) Final Report, a full accounting of monies spent and the results of the church planting ministry for the year. The final report should be submitted within one week of the one-year anniversary of receiving the initial installment.
